



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO 5-YEAR B.ARCH. PROGRAM (2025-2026)

Admission is governed by CoA (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020.

Academic Requirements:

Candidates must have passed 10+2 with:

Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with atleast 45% marks in aggregate or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with atleast 45% marks in aggregate.

No Lateral Admissions:


Direct lateral admission into any year/semester of the B.Arch. course is not permitted, regardless of qualifications.

NATA 2025 FOR ADMISSION TO B.ARCH PROGRAM

Candidates fulfilling the below criteria prescribed by the Council can appear for NATA 2025:

- i) Passed or appearing in 10+1 Examination with PCM Subjects;
- ii) Passed or appearing in 10+2 Examination with PCM subjects:
- iii) Passed or appearing in 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as subjects:

Please Note: Qualifying in NATA 2025 is mandatory and has fulfilled all the prescribed requirements as specified by respective competent authorities in compliance with the eligibility criteria laid down by the council.
